## **[ Rules and Regulations ]**

### **1. Organiser**

The tournament is co-organised by OTH, Tampines West CSN and Pathway Expert.

### **2. Objectives**

- 2.1. To provide an inclusive table tennis tournament for all levels of table tennis enthusiasts in Singapore.
- 2.2. To provide a level playing field for organisations/clubs/groups to compete.
- 2.3. To provide a platform of exciting and entertaining tournament with reward to keep participants active and engaged.

### **3. Tournament Date and Time**

- 3.1. 19 & 20 April 2025 Saturday & Sunday
- 3.2. 3 & 4 May 2025 Saturday & Sunday

### **4. Tournament Venue**

Community Auditorium 2 @ Our Tampines Hub (OTH) Level 3

### **5. Registration Fee**

Free

### **6. Eligibility of Players**

- 6.1. The tournament is open to all players regardless of gender, race, age and nationality.
- 6.2. The tournament is also open to all para-athletes.
- 6.3. Team is allowed to register maximum of 2 Singapore National athlete.

### **7. Format of Play**

It consists of 5 matches, they are:

- 7.1. Open Singles
- 7.2. Open Doubles
- 7.3. Open Singles
- 7.4. Open Doubles
- 7.5. Open Singles

## [ Rules and Regulations ]

### 8. Tournament System

- 8.1. Each team shall register maximum of 9 players (maximum of 2 Singapore National athletes).
- 8.2. All Players are only allowed to register with ONE team.
- 8.3. No repeated player(s) in each team match.
- 8.4. Being the first year of the tournament, all the participating teams will be drawn to 6 Pools with 6 teams per Pool.
- 8.5. The tournament in 2026 will base on the results in 2025 for the team placement:

For all the <u>6</u> Pools (2025)	Advanced to Division (2026)
1 <sup>st</sup> Position	1
<u>2<sup>nd</sup></u> Position	2
<u>3<sup>rd</sup></u> Position	3
<u>4<sup>th</sup></u> Position	4
<u>5<sup>th</sup></u> Position	<u>5</u>
<u>6<sup>th</sup></u> Position	<u>6</u>

- 8.6. The tournament in 2027 will base on the results in 2026 for the team placement:

- 8.7. Division 7 (2026 onwards) will be open to all new teams.
- 8.8. For each Pool (2025) or Division 1-6 (2006 onwards), the 6 teams will compete with each other in a round robin system, i.e. each team will play 5 matches.
- 8.9. All the matches shall be played to best of 5 games of 11 points each.

### 9. Dates

- 9.1. Registration Open : 3<sup>th</sup> January 2025 Friday
- 9.2. Registration Close : 1<sup>st</sup> April 2025 Tuesday
- 9.3. Draw for RR Group : 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 Monday
- 9.4. Fixture Release : 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 Monday (<https://www.pathway-expert.com/PEOS/>)
- 9.5. Deadline for team player changes: 15<sup>th</sup> April 2005 Tuesday

### 10. Registration

- 10.1. Fill in the Registration Form and email it to [pathwayexpert@gmail.com](mailto:pathwayexpert@gmail.com).
- 10.2. Registration shall be on first come first serve basis.
- 10.3. Addition, removal and/or replacement of team player(s) shall be allowed on/before the deadline. Payer is not allowed to transfer from another team after the Draw.

### 11. Prize Presentation

- 11.1. The Prize Presentation Ceremony shall be held immediately after tournament.

### 12. Rules and Regulations

- 12.1. The tournament shall be run in accordance with the latest rules and regulations of the international Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).
- 12.2. 3-star 40mm+ white balls shall be used.
- 12.3. No white apparels (shirt and shorts) shall be allowed.
- 12.4. It is not mandatory to wear uniform team attire.
- 12.5. No grace period.
- 12.6. No postponement of matches shall be allowed at any stage of the tournament.
- 12.7. Teams shall report to official table at least 30 minutes before the scheduled match. Team shall concede a walkover if the team is not on court at the scheduled time after the match has been announced on court.
- 12.8. All line-up form shall be submitted at least 10 minutes before the scheduled time. No changes to the line-up form shall be allowed after submission.
- 12.9. Team whose line-up form is not submitted on time would have its line-up pre-filled in descending order according to the team registration list.
- 12.10. Player who is not present for his/her match, he or she shall concede a walkover for that match and the teams shall proceed to play the next preceding match.
- 12.11. No fixture amendment or change of the play format shall be allowed.
- 12.12. Team Captains shall be responsible for the proper control and good conduct of their players and supporters.

## [ Rules and Regulations ]

### 13. General Provisions

- 13.1. The Tournament Organiser reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations, postponement or cancellation of the tournament at any time without prior notification. Any other rules decided by the Tournament Organiser shall be final.
- 13.2. In the event of any dispute, the match shall be played under protest. The Tournament Organiser shall determine the matter on receipt of the protest in writing, together with the protest fee SGD 100, within 24 hours after that match. Decision arising from any protest shall be final and there shall be no appeal.

### 14. Indemnity

- 14.1. Participant should be sufficiently fit to compete in the event.
- 14.2. Participant should understand and accept that the Tournament Organiser does not accept any liability of any sort for bodily injury, illness or death sustained to or by the participant or loss or damage to any of participant's possessions or goods whatsoever and howsoever their loss or damage is caused.
- 14.3. Participant should also consent to the recording of his/her voice, image and likeness captured by any means including cameras/telephones/mobile devices while present in, at or about the tournament and the transmission of these images/voices in perpetuity by the Tournament Organiser free of charge, by any means and waives all moral and legal rights in and to any recordings of sound made or images taken within the Tournament venue.
